The Best Practices Awards program provides unique awards which recognizes achievement with implementation of construction industry Best Practices which have been validated by the Construction Industry Institute (CII) to provide improvements in cost and schedule. There are currently 17 Best Practices which have been validated.

Submission Requirements

- ◆ Best Practices Award application
- ◆ Executive Summary - One page summary of the project outlining the project and the Best Practices implemented and quantified results (i.e. 200 - 300 words).
- ◆ Participating Organizations - List of organizations (with key contact information) contributing significantly to the project's success.
- ◆ Detailed Description - Identify Best Practices implemented (***no more than 2***) which had the most positive impact on your project.
- ◆ For each Best Practice, respond to the specific questions associated with the Best Practice.
- ◆ Metrics - Provide quantifiable results of improvement based on best practice implementation in cost, schedule, quality, and / or safety.

Submissions may be made electronically in 8 ½" x 11" in pdf format to a Dropbox site by Monday, January 29, 2018.
