CII BEST PRACTICE: FRONT-END PLANNING

Tarlton Corporation and Washington University has been selected as the winner of the St Louis Council of Construction Consumers Best Practice for the Front-End Planning. The project involved replacement of an old, narrow pedestrian bridge over Forest Park Parkway and the Metro Link Line, with an 18-foot-wide pedestrian bridge. Front End Planning was critical to this project in order to minimize disruption of vehicular and pedestrian traffic, better coordination with jurisdictional authorities, schedule improvements and cost savings. But what are the lessons learned? Come learn what made this project's front end planning effort paid off!

CII BEST PRACTICE: PARTNERING

S. M. Wilson and Habitat for Humanity have been selected as the winner of the St Louis Council of Construction Consumers Best Practice for Partnering. A project with many participating companies requires good communication and collaboration to execute a successful project. As a result of utilizing CII's Best Practice of Partnering, the following metrics were attained:

- A \$3,000,000 project was completed for \$2,000,000
- 890 Volunteers donated 6,095 hours of work saving over \$149,000
- \$979,000 worth of donated services and materials were obtained
- 16 different companies participated in the project
- Reused salvaged parts for the construction project to avoid landfill disposal
