# JOIN AN SLC3 COMMITTEE!

### □ AGC Liaison (Owners Only)

The AGC Liaison Committee is charged with meeting quarterly with the Associated General Contractors to address concerns in the construction industry. Meets quarterly.

### Awards Gala (Judges Required)

The Best Practices & Awards Committee is charged with promoting the use of recognized Best Practices and recognizing outstanding accomplishments through the Best Practices Awards. Meets for a few months.

### Construction Alliance (Owners Only)

The Construction Alliance is a joint committee between the Council, AGC, AIA, ACEC, IFMA and CSI to develop and promote guidelines for the St. Louis Construction industry. Meets quarterly.

### Diversity & Inclusion

The Diversity Committee is charged with assessing diversity in design and construction and fostering greater diversity and inclusion in work force and among consumers of construction. Meets monthly on last Friday of month.

### □ Executive Committee (Owners Only)

The Executive Committee is the highest level leadership branch of the organization working with the Executive Director overseeing the ongoing operations of the Council, making recommendations to the Board of Directors and acting on behalf of the Board between meetings. Meets monthly on first Thursday of month.

### 🗆 Golf

The Golf Committee is charged with offering an opportunity for owners, contractors, design professionals and other industry professionals to network and interact in a non-business setting, thus enhancing industry communication. Meets January thru April.

### MCA Liaison (Owners Only)

The MCA Liaison Committee is meets quarterly with the Mechanical Contractors Association to address industry concerns with mechanical contractors and pipefitters.

### Membership

The Membership Committee is charged with increasing membership in the Council, especially by owners. Meets monthly the last Tuesday in afternoon.

### Missouri Growth Association (Owners Only)

The Council appoints a Director to the Board of Directors of the MGA and coordinates with MGA on government and regional development policy concerns.

### Health & Safety

The Safety and Substance Abuse Committee is charged with developing programs that increase safety and that eliminate substance abuse. Meets monthly on second Tuesday at 1 p.m..

### Training and Education (2 Yr Commitment)
