

PROGRAM SUMMARY

With rising alarm, mental health and suicide have become a crisis in the construction industry. Join us for an interactive session with speakers representing owners, contractors, and trade organizations.

Creating a culture of caring and support is imperative for all of us. Those in the construction industry are three times more likely to take their lives than other fields. They are also six times more likely to die from suicide than a fall from height. Pressures in the industry and the stress of the work are major contributing factors.

Another key factor is stigma. The program's topics will include both contractor's and owner's perspectives on the importance of mental health initiatives in the trades; mitigating barriers and stigma which prevent workers from asking for help, and best practices implemented locally and nationally to address this crisis.
