▣ Awards Gala (Judges Required)

The awards gala is held in Spring each year. The committee plans overall details with the primary responsibilities being with the SLC3 staff. However, the committee is comprised of best practices volunteers and DEI volunteers to help to oversee the judging for these categories. Separate judging events are held. Committee members are encourage to help to support the event on the day of for set up or registration. The committee members must be dedicated to reviewing submissions during the time allotted for judging.

▣ Diversity, Equity and Inclusion

The Diversity Committee is charged with assessing diversity in design and construction and fostering greater diversity and inclusion in work force and among consumers of construction. Addressing today's specific challenges is part of our mission towards a more equitable region.

▣ Emerging Leaders

Emerging leaders is a committee comprised primarily of those in roles where they are working to advance in their careers or learn more about the industry. They plan networking and training events throughout the year.

▣ Executive Committee (Owners Only)

The Executive Committee is the highest level leadership branch of the organization working with the Executive Director overseeing the ongoing operations of the Council, making recommendations to the Board of Directors and acting on behalf of the Board between meetings. Meets monthly on first Thursday of month.

▣ Golf Tournament

The Golf Committee helps to plan the golf tournament but is mainly requested to contact companies for sponsorships and participation in our golf tournament fundraiser. Meets December thru April. The golf tournament is always the first Monday in May.

▣ Membership

The Membership Committee are the ambassadors for retention and for growth of the organization. Reaching out to new members and encouraging new memberships are responsibilities. Other tasks include supporting the sponsorships for the SLC3 as well. As ambassadors we hope you will want to attend as many events as possible encouraging new members to join and existing members to engage further.

▣ Health & Safety

The Health & Safety Committee meets monthly to collaborate on challenges, trends, newly implement procedures therefore developing peer to peer knowledge and insights for health and safety in the region. The committee members also plan two health and safety forums per year for educational purposes. The Training and Education Committee is charged with developing programming and coordinating monthly programs or seminars and networking events.

▣ Sporting Clays

This committee meets a few times to plan the annual Sporting Clays event fundraiser. The committee will review the budget, pricing, any giveaways, food, venue and prizes. The committee is requested to assist with securing sponsorships for the event as well. We ask committee members to publicize the event via their companies and on social media.

▣ Strategic Planning

This committee is primarily made up of owner member representatives with a greater knowledge base of the SLC3 operations and mission. Associate members are invited to participate in about 5-6 in person sessions while in the process of strategic planning and reviewing the draft prior to being approved by the Board.

▣ Training and Education (2 Yr Commitment)

The Training and Education Committee is responsible for providing insight into trending topics in the AEC industry, owner or associate specific challenges and best practices, training on construction industry best practices, and technology related topics. Other topics can be related to financial and legal or project management. Each member of the committee is required to sit on two subcommittees per year to plan a program. More experienced members are requested to Chair as subcommittee which is responsible for finalizing the topic, speaker(s) and helping to coordinate information to council staff. Participation at events is heavily encouraged.

▣ Women's Leadership

The women's leadership committee meets to plan monthly trainings over lunch and quarterly activities. The planning includes helping with venue ideas, topics and identifying speakers. Coordinating with speakers is also requested for their bio, photo and program summary.

▣ Workforce Committee

The Workforce Committee is charged with identifying workforce needs and keeping on top of region. This committee is not currently meeting but building up. If interested let us know.
