Criteria:

1. Project Excellence (15)

- Quality of Work: Demonstrates superior craftsmanship, attention to detail, and adherence to project specifications.
- Client Satisfaction: Consistently receives positive feedback from clients, including repeat business or referrals.
- Timely Delivery: Successfully completes projects on or ahead of schedule without compromising quality.

2. Business Growth and Performance (15)

- Market Penetration: Achieves significant growth in market share or enters competitive markets effectively.
- Revenue Growth: Shows consistent and substantial year-over-year revenue increases.
- New Project Wins: Successfully secures high-profile or complex projects through competitive bids or recognized expertise.

Peer Recognition: Receives awards or accolades from industry peers or organizations.

 Published Projects: Gains media or industry publication coverage for noteworthy projects or achievements.

10. Vision and Strategic Goals

- Clear Mission: Operates with a defined mission and values that guide its growth and decisionmaking.
- Strategic Planning: Executes a well-thought-out plan for expansion, diversification, or market leadership.
- Long-Term Potential: Shows promise for becoming a major player in the design or construction industry.

Evaluation Process

- Documentation: Include project portfolios, client testimonials, growth metrics, and case studies to validate claims.
- Judging Panel: Includes experts in business growth, construction, and design to evaluate submissions holistically.
- Weighted Criteria: Higher weight to growth potential and innovation, given the company's emerging status.

Scoring and Evaluation Process

Weighted Criteria: We will assign weight to each criterion based on its importance to our organization.

Panel Review: A diverse panel of judges representing different industry perspectives will be used to complete impartial evaluations. Highest score will win the award. Nominees will likely be finalists.
