#### Criteria:

#### **Criteria for Tradesperson of the Year Award**

This award recognizes an outstanding skilled tradesperson in the construction industry who exemplifies excellence, professionalism, and leadership. Nominees should inspire others through their expertise, attitude, and contributions to the success of their projects and teams.

#### 1. Exceptional Skill and Craftsmanship (25%)

- Description: Demonstrates superior technical skills and craftsmanship that set them apart in their trade.
- Key Points to Consider:
  - Mastery of trade-specific techniques and tools.
  - Consistent delivery of high-quality workmanship.
  - o Innovative solutions to complex challenges on-site.

#### 2. Depth of Knowledge (20%)

- Description: Possesses extensive knowledge of their trade and applies it effectively to enhance project outcomes.
- Key Points to Consider:
  - Understanding of industry standards, codes, and best practices.
  - Ability to train, mentor, or guide less experienced colleagues.
  - O Staying up-to-date with advancements and technologies in their field.

#### 3. Leadership and Mentorship (20%)

- Description: Leads by example and inspires others through their work ethic, guidance, and positive influence.
- Key Points to Consider:
  - Taking initiative to address challenges and improve team performance.
  - Supporting and mentoring apprentices or junior tradespeople.
  - Fostering a culture of safety, collaboration, and respect on-site.

#### 4. Positive Attitude and Work Ethic (15%)

- Description: Maintains a can-do attitude and demonstrates a strong commitment to their work and team.
- Key Points to Consider:
  - Reliability, punctuality, and consistency in delivering results.
  - o Demonstrating resilience and adaptability in challenging situations.
  - o Actively contributing to team morale and productivity.

#### 5. Teamwork and Collaboration (10%)

- Description: Excels in working collaboratively with colleagues, contractors, and clients to achieve shared goals.
- Key Points to Consider:
  - o Effective communication and problem-solving with team members.
  - Ability to build strong working relationships across disciplines.
  - Willingness to step up and support others when needed.

#### 6. Professionalism and Integrity (10%)

- Description: Represents the highest standards of conduct in their role as a skilled tradesperson.
- Key Points to Consider:
  - Demonstrating honesty, accountability, and respect for others.
  - Acting as an ambassador for the construction industry.
  - o Representing their company or trade with pride and excellence.

#### **Nomination Guidelines**

- Nomination Narrative (1,000 words max): Explain why this individual deserves the award, addressing the criteria above with specific examples.
- Endorsements: Include at least one letter of support from a colleague, supervisor, or client.
- Evidence of Excellence: Provide examples of completed projects, testimonials, or other documentation showcasing their impact.
- Optional Media: Photos or videos demonstrating their work or highlighting their role in a team or project.
